

MY TRAINING JOURNEY

If you want to give your players a great rugby experience you should be aiming to get on the journey to 'skilled expert.' This will be achieved through a combination of applied coaching and/or refereeing practice and developing your rugby knowledge.

Everyone should be trained in best practice around player safety and safeguarding to reduce the risk of injury or harm to players. This should include concussion awareness training and an understanding of how to safely coach and referee the contact areas of rugby union.



PLAYER WELFARE

COURSE	MIN AGE	DESCRIPTION	COST
Emergency First Aid in Rugby Union	16	1 day The EFARU course provides learners with the skills, knowledge and understanding to give care and manage minor injuries, focusing on those occurring in a rugby setting. The course sits on the national qualification framework (Level 3 Emergency First Aid at Work) and is transferable into the workplace.	£75
Play it Safe	16	2.5 hours For any volunteer, coach or match official who is working with or has responsibility for children and vulnerable adults.	£20
Headcase Concussion Awareness <u>Access the course here</u>	15	eLearning – 30 minutes This course explains what concussion is, how it happens and what individuals can do to help players avoid injury and return safely to play following a concussion.	FREE
Introduction to Safeguarding <u>Access the course here</u>	16	eLearning – 30 minutes For everyone working in rugby union who is providing supervised or unsupervised instruction to have a basic understanding of what safeguarding and protecting young people means.	FREE
TackleSafe <u>Access the course here</u>	14	eLearning – 30 minutes Competence in tackling and taking a tackle is critical in developing a safer and more enjoyable game. This course helps to support safe, effective coaching and officiating of the tackle.	FREE



ACTIVATE







Activate is the RFU's Injury Prevention Exercise Programme

It can be integrated into training and pre-match sessions. Exercises are designed to improve functional and core strength, balance and agility, helping players with the game's physical demands.



The Activate eLearning course (see page 12), gives you access to a range of digital resources to enhance your understanding and help your coaching.

This can also be shared with players so they can practice these exercises on their own.

Research conducted with schoolboy and adult male players found that when completed 3 times a week (twice before training and on a match day) the programme led to a reduction in injuries, including concussion.

COURSE	MIN AGE	DESCRIPTION	COST
Kids First Tag Rugby	14	2 hours For those coaching and refereeing U6-U8 players. This course supports the development of active, purposeful, enjoyable and safe tag rugby environments for children. Participants will also learn the rules and practice refereeing tag rugby.	£20
Kids First Contact Rugby	14	2 x 3 hour sessions This course is for Coaches, Referees and Teachers new to contact rugby. England Rugby Coaching Award	16	2 days + monthly webinars and online community of practice Entry point for those coaching U12 and above. Provide coaches with the knowledge, skills and attributes to safely and effectively coach young players and adults.	£100
England Rugby Refereeing Award	14	2 days + monthly webinars and online community of practice Entry point for those refereeing U12 and above. Provide coaches with the knowledge, skills and attributes to safely and effectively referee young players and adults.	£75
England Rugby Advanced Coaching Award Previously Level 3 Coaching	18	12 month programme: 4 face to face days, webinars, practical observations and community of practice events Applicants must have a minimum of 3 years experience as an England Rugby Coaching Award/Level 2 coach before applying.	£1100
England Rugby Advanced Match Official Award	18	12 month programme: 4 face to face days, webinars, practical observations and community of practice events The course is by invitation only and is aimed at panel referees with the potential to officiate in the high performance game.	N/A
